Accordingly, here we provide you a brief of the topics of our four task forces, in order to have all the necessary information to choose delegates with experience and knowledge in the areas:




Education and Skills for the 21st Century:

SUGGESTED CRITERIA FOR THE SELECTION OF YOUTH REPRESENTATIVES

- Aged between 18 and 30;
- keep gender balance nominating one delegate per gender (male, female or other).
- Deep knowledge of, at least, one of the task forces topics;
- Valid Passport with Visa;
- Fluent English;
- Non government employee;
- Commitment to work 10 hours per month on follow-up actions of Y20 over a period of 12 months;
- Understanding of global problems with a multicultural perspective;
- Ideally one delegate should have a strong academic background, and the other should have volunteer experience or be currently an active participant of a Youth Platform or relevant NGO or be involved in community service projects regarding youth matters.

Board and accommodation in Cordoba, Argentina, will be provided by the Y20 organization. However, each country should cover the expenses for the round trip to Córdoba, Argentina, from their countries. Each delegate is responsible to get the Visa, if necessary, to enter to Argentina.
